## What is AutoIQ



Information is organized into seven main automotive areas consisting of fuel management, engine management, heating and air conditioning, ignition system, brakes, suspension and steering and engine mechanical. Each of these categories is then further divided into detailed subcategories where individual users can obtain the specific interactive information that is of interest to them.

Near the top of the home page, you will see a horizontal bar with menu options. Move your mouse over **Reference & Research**, and a menu will appear. Move your mouse so that it highlights **Databases** on this menu, and a submenu will drop down. Click on "Do It Yourself" to open a new page.



**Auto Repair Reference Center** will appear among the databases. Click on the Auto Repair icon.

*If you are accessing the database from outside the library, you will first be prompted for your library barcode.*

## Printing Images

Sometimes when printing an image in Automotive Repair Reference Center, the image will appear very small on the printed page. The following steps will help you print the image properly:

1. Right Click on the image you would like to print.
2. Select **Print Picture**.
3. Click the **Preferences** button in the Print dialog box.
4. Under the Orientation settings, select the **Landscape** radio button.
5. Place a check in the **Manual Scaling** check box and adjust scaling to fit your page.
6. Click **OK**.
7. Click **Print**.


