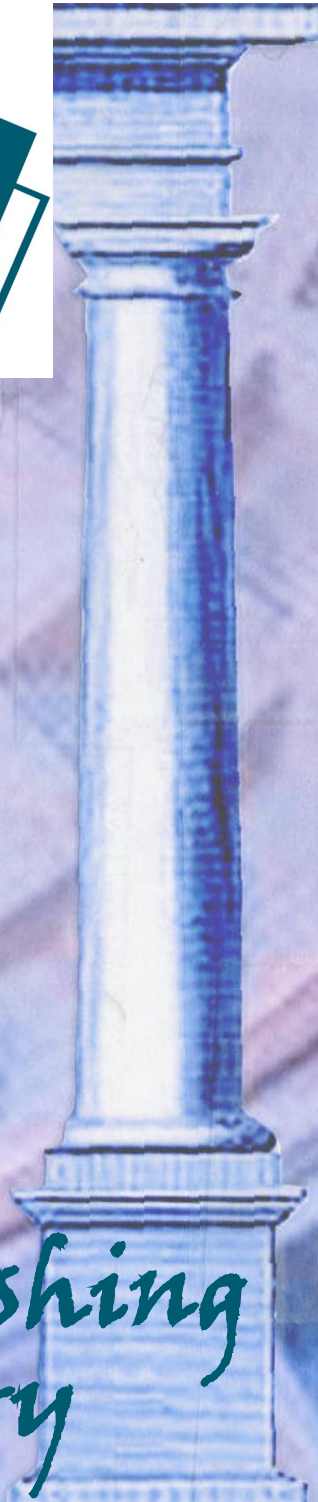

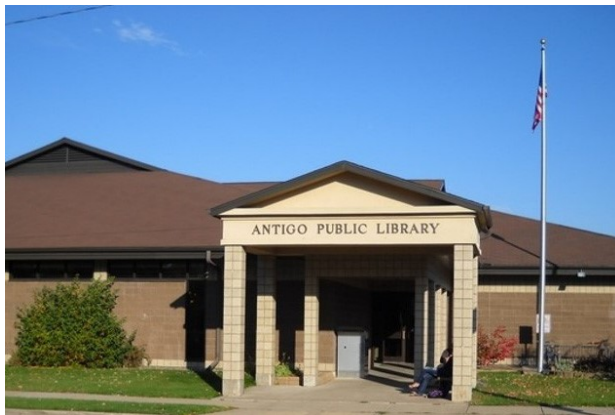

The Antigo Public Library Foundation, Inc., is a 501c3 tax-exempt, private, nonprofit corporation that provides supplementary support for the Library. Because the demands for library services and the needs and opportunities facing the library are growing faster than the public funds available to support them, the goal of the Foundation is to enrich, not replace, traditional tax-based support through private fundraising from individuals, businesses, and foundations. Public dollars fund a fine library for the citizens of the City of Antigo and Langlade County, but it is private gifts that make it flourish!



HOW THE FOUNDATION SUPPORTS THE LIBRARY

From its beginning in 1905, the Antigo Public Library has received support from private individuals in addition to its public funding. The Antigo Public Library Foundation assures that contributions will supplement, but never replace, public funds.

Helen Tomany chose to give the community the chance to enjoy learning as much as she did. Her \$250,000 bequest to the Antigo Public Library provided the impetus to construct the new facility, with additional dollars coming from the city, county, and a spirited fundraising effort on behalf of the Antigo Public Library Foundation in 1997.

HOW TO GIVE

Larger gifts may be made through bequests or deferred contributions to an endowment fund.
