Accessing the Database

You can access *Home Improvement* from our library web site at *www.antigopl.org*

Near the top of the home page, you will see a horizontal bar with menu options. Move your mouse over **Reference & Research**, and a menu will appear. Move your mouse so that it highlights **Databases** on this menu, and a submenu will drop down. Click on "Do-It-Yourself" to open a new page.



There are three databases on this page. Scroll down and click on the *Home Improvement* icon.

If you are using this database within the library, a single click takes you to the **Home Improvement** site.

If you are accessing the database from outside the library, you will first be prompted for your 14-digit library card barcode.

Using the Database

At the *Home Improvement* home page, in the upper right corner, you will find a "Help" link. Click on this feature, and a separate page will open. The left column of this new page will offer you more information on searching, saving your searches, printing and emailing, using folders, etc.

In addition, there are: a library of videos, information on working with contractors, and conversion charts.
